[JUMP](#) (a Social Bicycles project) is building the future of urban mobility: shared electric bikes that are the quickest, most enjoyable, and most empowering way to get around a city. Cheaper than most public transit and faster than cars in traffic, JUMP e-bikes are game-changers for local transportation. JUMP currently has systems in the San Francisco Bay Area and Washington DC, and we have plans to expand to at least five major US cities in the next year. Our goal is to transform cities, making them more sustainable, equitable, and livable through electric mobility.

About the Role

JUMP is excited to bring e-bikes to San Francisco! In the coming months, JUMP will deploy hundreds of electric-assist bicycles across the city, fundamentally improving the transportation landscape for many San Franciscans. In order to reduce our operations burden and increase the availability of fully charged bikes, JUMP will deploy a network of charging stations on private properties across the city. We're seeking a highly-motivated and detail-oriented professional to manage all aspects of the deployment of a robust charging station network in San Francisco. This is a great opportunity to play a direct and crucial role in establishing and shaping new transportation system while gaining experience project managing the creation of a complex EV charging network with multiple internal and external stakeholders.

This is a full-time opportunity. Candidates must be willing to spend the majority all of their time in San Francisco, with the potential for travel to other JUMP cities.

Responsibilities

- Manage the permitting and onboarding process for new charging station location partners.
 - Lead and define the process of working with interested partners to install charging stations.
 - Facilitate communication between external partners, relevant San Francisco government departments, electrical contractors, and internal SoBi stakeholders.
- Initiate, spearhead, and negotiate business development efforts with potential charging station partners across San Francisco.
- Learn and navigate San Francisco's Planning Code and Building Inspection process, attending Planning Commission meetings and attending Building Inspection open hours when necessary.
- Manage JUMP's relationships with its partners, electrical contractors, and relevant city officials.
- Clearly and effectively communicate project details to multiple SoBi teams:
 - Synthesize detailed electrical and planning code requirements into digestible reports that inform our installation process and guide product development.
 - Work closely with the SoBi legal team to help manage contracts with external partners.
 - Generate actionable reports and communicate installation timelines to help guide SoBi's launch strategy.
 - Help site planners collect relevant site measurements and details.
